We are pleased to send you the Call for Exhibitors for the 128th AES Convention to be held in London, UK, in May 2010 at the Novotel London West Convention Centre.

2009 will no doubt be remembered as a challenging year for all of us. The world's economic climate has put many to the test, challenging us to o p t i m i z e o u r existing resources and driving us to finding new ones. To d a y's world encourages us to p ut things in



perspective, to consider our goals and strengthen our assets for the future.

AES too has made that exercise. Rather than filling these few introductory lines with references to AES's history and past, we want to look to the future. As a professional and scientific society brought forth by the audio community, we owe it to the audio industry to continue to provide a platform that allows scientific research and market development to sit alongside each other and to allow the attendee to see both. London, past or future?

On three occasions in the past, the last 23 years ago, London has hosted the AES Convention. Going back to London is not stepping back in time, but taking the opportunity to be in one of the foremost audio cities of the world, with its broadcasting, recording, post production and film industries. It is also hosting the 2012 Olympics with all the infrastructure requirements that this will bring.

By choosing the Novotel London West Convention Centre the Exhibits and the Technical Programme can be placed in close proximity, together with Demo and Meeting Rooms. There is also the benefit of a 600 room hotel in which rooms have been blocked for the convention. There are bars, lounge areas, eating and hospitality options. The venue is easy to get to from Heathrow airport by Underground in forty minutes and from central London in twenty. Transport from all over London and beyond is available only a few minutes away. Shops and entertainment and all that London has to offer are within easy reach.


Exhibit space

Exhibit stand-spaces are available from 3m x 3m upwards and may be increased in 1m increments. All rented space is carpeted (blue and grey). All rented stand space includes a 1kW power connection, free listing and product preview in the exhibitor directory, free listing and product preview in the Journal of the AES Convention issue, free listing on the AES website, free guest invitations, free staff badges, access to sponsoring opportunities and the possibility to hold exhibitor seminars.

Space only – Custom design stands

Bring and build your own stand. Building guidelines will be available in the exhibitor manual.

Alternatively, you can use the AES appointed stand builder to design and build your custom designed stand.



Standard Booth

A standard booth construction consisting of white shell scheme walls and carpet (blue and grey) is provided. Also included: 1kW power connection, 3x120W spotlights per 9m² unit, stand fascia with your company name. You can bring your own furniture or rent furniture of your choice from our supplier.

Plug & Play Pack

The easiest way to participate: the Plug and Play Package consists of a standard booth construction and a set of furniture. The Plug & Play furniture pack consists of a welcome desk and barstool, 1 table, 4 chairs. All you need to do is to bring your equipment and you are ready for business!
