### Systems Integration:

- Solder, crimp, and terminate audio, video, and control cabling.
- Ring out, troubleshoot, and commission installations independently.

### Qualifications:

- Film, production, or broadcast Experience.
- Bachelor's degree in relevant area or equivalent experience.
- Cross-platform computer literacy including OSX, Windows, and Linux.
- Knowledge of digital video and audio signals and systems is essential.

- Knowledge of AutoCAD a plus.
- Proficiency in the use of test equipment including oscilloscopes, waveform monitors and voltage meters a plus.
