B) <u>Workshop</u> on "Influence of weather on Sound Reinforcement". Some areas which can be included in such a session are Audience area related issues, Impact on surrounding community.

5) Joel Lewitz (TCASR member) was suggested as liason to the San Fransisco 1998 convention committee.

6) A discussion then followeed on the subjects of "Hot Topics" and "TC visibility". The Chair suggested that a TC session might be one way of attracting attention to the work of the TCs.
