1) The chair opened the meeting by discussing the agenda. The agenda was approved.

4) Two activities were suggested for the San Francisco convention pending approval from the San Francisco 1998 AES convention committee. These were:

A) Session on "New developments in the fields of Sound Reinforcement and Sound Field Enhancement". Some areas which can be included in such a session are Measurements, design methods, implemented systems.

B) Workshop on "Influence of weather on Sound Reinforcement". Some areas which can be included in such a session are Audience area related issues, Impact on surrounding community.

5) Joel Lewitz (TCASR member) was suggested as liason to the San Francisco 1998 convention committee.

6) A discussssion then followeed on the subjects of "Hot Topics" and "TC visibility". The Chair suggested that a TC session might be one way of attracting attention to the work of the TCs.
