The importance of audio functionality in handheld devices has grown rapidly. As more handheld devices embrace the Internet via wireless connectivity, they are constantly evolving to become even more powerful hosts of multimedia contents. Considering the fast-changing environment of personal devices, it is timely for a conference to discuss the trends and future of audio technologies for wireless-enabled handheld devices connected to one other and also to home music systems. This conference will focus on the state-of-the-art developments of audio technologies for wirelessly networked handheld devices. This three-day conference aims to bring audio and system engineers together for the discussion. During the conference, we will discuss issues including wireless audio, new paradigms of coding technologies, immersive 3-D audio, synthetic audio, audio signal processing for future applications, and issues regarding system implementations of personal devices.

The Committee invites submission of technical papers for presentation at the conference in 2011 at POSTECH in Pohang, Republic of Korea. A full-length paper between 4 and 10 pages should be submitted by June 1, 2011 to the review committee of the 43rd AES Conference. Paper templates will be available for downloading at www.aes.org/43rd_authors. You can visit this site for more information and complete instructions for using the site anytime after 2011 February 1. Based on full-paper submissions, the 43rd Conference Review Committee will determine acceptance and inform the authors before June 17, 2011 via email. After acceptance, minor revisions based on the comments of the reviewers will be allowed, but not substantial rewriting. Revised papers must be submitted by July 15, 2011.

The Committee also invites submission of proposals for workshops and tutorials. Before 2011 June 1, email all the pertinent information—title, workshop or tutorial, 125-word abstract, proposed workshop chair or tutorial presenter, possible panel speakers, preferred event duration, and special facility needs—to the workshops chair at 43rd_workshops@aes.org.
