
QUALIFIED ATTENDEES BY TITLE


ranking, very influential people within our industry. Students and Education represent audio's bright future and Others our entrepreneurs.

INTERNATIONAL ATTENDEES BY COUNTRY




Qualified International attendees were over 10% of the total attendance from over 74 countries.
