3. Recording & Production Track (<http://www.aes.org/events/139/recording/>)

These events were planned by the AES NY Convention Committee, and guided by Alan Silverman. Various members of the TC-RTP are participating in these workshops and panels, including Maureen Droney, Jonathan Wyner, Alex Case, Andres Mayo, George Massenburg, Rob Toulson, and Jim Kaiser.

4. Maureen Droney (MD) introduced a discussion of the Recording Information Notification (RIN) and DDEX. There is a draft document in development, and coordination of the implementation as a field set with the delivery standard. It is encouraged that TC-RTP be involved in advocacy, with John Spencer acting as a go-between due to his role in both groups. Alex Case (AC) inquired about expanding the metadata, and MD indicated that there are 20 criteria at present.

5. Rob Toulson (RT) provided a brief recap of activities related to TC-RTP at the 138th in Warsaw. This included mention of a Mixing & Mastering Panel (to be repeated in NY). AC noted that TC-RTP was well-represented at the Warsaw event, and Jonathan Wyner (JW) indicated that there was great student participation, and well-attended education events. RT also volunteered to help manage a meeting of the RTP in Paris.

6. Toru Kamakara reported that the AES Japan Section is involved in the development of a Spatial Reproduction Conference to be held in 2018, with the proposal being submitted to CfPC. More details will be forthcoming.

7. A discussion of ways to enhance and promote the activities of the TC-RTP, especially via electronic media resulted in the following recommendations:

- Use the Forum in coming weeks to formulate ideas further;
- JW will ask Mobiltape if OK to make use of portions of their convention recordings for 'teasers' from previous AES Conventions;
- Use on-going convention workshop/tutorials as 'teasers' to the next event;
- Find a member of the RTP to take on role of updating the TC-RTP site, which is presently managed by Francis Rumsey (FR);
- Use Wikipedia links to bring viewers in.

8. There being no more business, the meeting was adjourned at approx.1:00pm.
